How do I check for Operating System updates on my Samsung Galaxy device?

Samsung Galaxy S10 How to update the software on your phone

Operating system updates are released periodically for your device. If you are having difficulty with your device, you should always check for updates as a fix for the problem may have been released.

Software updates fall into two general types: operating system updates and security updates. Please note that the type and version of available updates will depend on your model.

Android code names are named after sweets and treats, with major new versions released annually. You'll often see operating system updates referred to by their name rather than the version number, however on your device the Android version you are using will be displayed as a number rather than a name.

Checking for updates

The location of the operating system updates will differ depending on the device you are using and its operating system. Follow the steps that correspond to your current Android version.

Please note: updates may take some time to install and can be large to download. It's recommended to download the update via a Wi-Fi connection to avoid using your mobile data allowance

To make sure that your device is always up-to-date it's reccomended to switch on **Auto update** (Lollipop/KitKat devices) or **Download updates automatically** (Marshmallow devices and above)






